

## **Hanscom Spouses Club Scholarship Program**

## **Military Spouse Scholarship Guidelines 2022**

The Hanscom Spouses Club (HSC) of Hanscom Air Force Base is a private organization developed as a welfare and social forum for the spouses of our military members. Members of this club volunteer countless hours supporting fundraising events and services that benefit the Hanscom Air Force Base Community. For the past 59 years, since 1961, this Club has offered scholarships to graduating high school senior military dependents and to military spouses for over 20 of those years. The intent of these scholarships is to support graduating high school seniors and spouses of members of any branch of the armed forces (Air Force, Army, Navy, Marines, Coast Guard, Space Force, including dependents of Reservists or National Guard whose sponsor must have been activated during the 2021-2022 school year for a minimum of 120 days and is able to provide a copy of their orders at time of application submission).

- 1. Applicants must meet the following criteria:
  - a. Planning to seek an undergraduate, associate, Master's, Doctorate or other advanced degree from an accredited 2 or 4-year college, university or vocational-technical school. (Note: students who plan to seek a second undergraduate or a Master's, Doctorate or other advanced degree will be evaluated separately); and
  - b. A dependent of active duty, retired, or deceased military members of any branch of service; and
  - c. The applicant must be in possession, or eligible for possession, of a military ID card with full benefits; and
  - d. May not be currently serving as a member of the Hanscom Spouses Club Scholarship committee; and
  - e. Applicants must reside within a 60-mile radius of Hanscom AFB, MA: or
  - f. Be the dependent of a sponsor stationed at Hanscom Air Force Base
- 2. This is a merit-based scholarship that rewards students who demonstrate scholarship, citizenship, leadership and a diversity of interests. Selection is made by a panel of impartial judges.
- 3. Recipients are only eligible for one HSC scholarship, in their lifetime.
- 4. Each recipient is notified by mail of his or her selection.
- 5. The award money is sent directly to the student and is solely for the purposes of tuition and fees.
- 6. The awards are presented to the recipients on 13 May 2022. (location TBD; "may be virtual" due to COVID-19)
- 7. Applicants must be in possession of a valid military ID that does not expire on or before 15 May 2022. Award recipients must bring a copy of their military ID to the Award Ceremony on 13 May 2022 for verification purposes.
- 8. The award will be withdrawn if the recipient accepts a scholarship from another military Spouses' Club.
- 9. The award is withdrawn if the recipient fails to enroll in an institution of higher learning within six months of receiving said award. Written verification of enrollment will be requested from the school by the HSC.
- 10. The Hanscom Spouses Club reserves the right to increase, decrease, or withdraw any or all awards.
- 11. In addition to their application, all applicants must submit two typed letters of recommendation each from a different person. Forms are provided, but evaluators may use their own forms as long as they follow the directions on the forms provided. Other required attachments with the application are: the applicant's essay, an official transcript with the GPA of highest level of education completed (GED scores are acceptable), a self-addressed stamped envelope and self-certified statement of the validity of the documents.
- 12. I\_\_\_\_\_\_ (legal guardian of applicant and/or name of applicant) hereby grant permission to the rights of their/my name, image, likeness as recorded on audio or video tape without payment or any other consideration. I understand that my image may be edited, copied, exhibited, published or distributed and waive

the right to inspect or approve the finished product wherein my likeness appears. Additionally, I waive any right to royalties or other compensation arising or related to the use of my image or recording. I also understand that this material may be used in the award ceremony's program/local base newspaper (The Hansconian) and any presentations created by the Hanscom Spouse's Club and/or the local Air Force Association Chapter. By signing this release I understand this permission signifies that photographic or video recordings of me may be electronically displayed via the Internet or in the public educational setting.
